HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Government College for Women, Sonipat was established in the year 2018. The Government of Haryana opened this college after long pending demands of the people of Sonipat as there was no Government College at the District headquarters. It was started in a make-shift building of Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Murthal Adda Chowk, Sonipat with a strength of 178 students. However, the college shifted to its new building at Sector-12, Sonipat on October 1, 2022.

HUMAN RESOURCE

In the session 2022-23, the total student strength of the college was 654. This college has three faculties—Arts, Commerce, and Journalism & Mass Communication. Sh. Dilbag Singh is working as a Principal of this college. There are 26 sanctioned posts of teachers. At present, 18 permanent Associate/Assistant Professors are working. The college is running seven courses, B.A, B.Com (P), B.Com (H), B.J.M.C, BSc Computer Science, B. A Geography (Hons) and M.A Political Science. In the office staff, there is a sanctioned post of Assistant, Clerk, Lab Attendant, Librarian, Steno typist (One each), and Peons (two). At present One Clerk (on a contractual basis), One Lab Attendant, and two Peons are working. In the Class IV category One Sweeper, one Mali and three Chowkidars are working on a contractual basis. There are three ITI apprentices working in different capacities in the college.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION RESULTS

The results of students for the session 2022-23 were better than the pass percentage of Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, Khanpur Kalan, Sonipat. Our students got excellent marks. (Result Sheet attached). All the students were promoted from Ist Year to IInd Year and II Year to III Year as per the guidelines of BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan, Sonipat.
